<b>1</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Listen to all twelve of Dr. Bill Pierce's <u>lessons on the book of Hebrews</u>. Take good notes, and submit a copy of these notes.</li> <li>• Read the book of <u>Hebrews</u> (using a King James Bible) through five times, and prepare a reading log according to the following example: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ <b>Date:</b> 9-12-97 <b>Time:</b> 4:45 - 11 pm <b>Pages:</b> 1-45</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Read <u>A Way Into the Holiest</u> and complete a reading log, as shown above.</li> <li>• Write a one-page summary, typed and double-spaced, for each chapter in the book of Hebrews. The summary is to be based on the material in Dr. Pierce's lectures, the material in the textbook, and your own personal observations as you read the Scripture.</li> </ul>
<b>2</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Prepare, tape record, and submit for grading a series of 3 expository messages covering any 3 chapters of Hebrews that interest you. Each message should be from 30 to 45 minutes in length.</li> </ul>
<b>3</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Read the notes on Hebrews that are contained in <u>Matthew Henry's Commentary</u>. Complete a reading log, as shown above.</li> </ul>
